MAN SENT TO JAIL FOR DEAD TWIN BROTHER'S CRIMES

(1) Mitch Torbett was arrested for a crime allegedly committed by his dead twin brother, Mike. It's been over two years since the death of his twin sibling and just a few weeks ago Mitch was picked up by Signal Mountain Police officers after trying to apply for a job as a nursing assistant. When his application was being vetted, they also looked at his criminal record. That's when the warrant for his arrest came to light.

(2) Although Torbett pleaded with police insisting that this federal warrant was issued for his brother, officials arrested him and turned his case over to the FBI. The weird thing was that Mitch's name actually was on the federal warrant. But after further investigation, they found that his brother's name was in all the police reports. Alas, suspicion started to creep in. It was only when Mitch went before a judge and the FBI presented fingerprints from both brothers that officials finally believed that he wasn't a crook.

(3) Torbett lucked out of what could have been imminent jail time. Instead he's been spending his time working with attorney Ken Nugent to file a civil lawsuit against the Signal Mountain police department, demanding \$ 5 million in compensation for false incarceration.
